

# LONGFIELD CALLING!

**Dancers, spoken-word artists, stand-ups, theatre-makers, musicians, storytellers, got a creative itch you want to scratch?**

Following the appointment of our new Artistic Director, Stella Barnes, we are now programming our autumn 2018 season. Whether you want to test out a work-in-progress or you have a fully realised piece to share, we would love to hear from you.

**About us:** Longfield Hall is a small venue between Camberwell and Brixton. Alongside a youth and community programme, we present new performance work.

We were the home of the first publicly funded Black-led theatre company, Dark and Light in the 1970s and we have been a thriving local venue for generations.

Our studio has a brand-new sprung floor and has an audience capacity of 50-100 depending on layout.

**How we work with artists:** Artists and companies are offered between one and four performances and up to five days free rehearsal space, depending on the stage of development and length of run. Fees are based on a box office split. Longfield Hall produces flyers for performances and develops a marketing campaign with the artist or company. It may be possible for artists to be programmed as part of a group scratch night, cabaret, rehearsed reading or spoken word event.

**Equality:** Longfield Hall is committed to equal opportunities and we are interested in work from artists of all ages and backgrounds. We are especially committed to supporting emerging artists.

**Access:** We are currently seeking planning permission to make our building wheelchair accessible, but until that is realised we regret that access is limited.

**How to submit a proposal:** Please send us a proposal of no more than 1,000 words in writing or up to three minutes in video. You must describe how your work addresses one or more of our priorities:

- **Diversity** -honouring our history, we are interested in work that is made by and for people of diverse backgrounds, identities, ages, cultures and interests.
- **Socially engaged and outward facing** – we are interested in work that engages with audiences and addresses barriers to access.
- **Relevant** - we want to programme work that has meaning for 21<sup>st</sup> century Londoners and is of interest to diverse local audiences.
- **Innovative** - we would like to hear about how your work approaches artistic form, content or audience engagement in an exciting way.
